As his flying career progressed David became a Captain and Training Captain with Pel-Air Aviation (now a wholly owned subsidiary of Regional Express Airlines) where he made a strategic career move accepting the role of Compliance and Safety Manager leading to senior positions including Company Corporate Manager and Management Committee Chairman.

During the years 2009 and 2010, David joined ExecuJet Australasia as Asia Pacific Quality & Safety Manager and was responsible for all Flight Operations and Aircraft Maintenance compliance management and assurance systems for ExecuJet bases throughout the Asia Pacific including; Australia, Malaysia and New Zealand.
